Hearts With Hands Disaster Relief Responds to flooding in Eastern Kentucky

Swannanoa, NC, August 11, 2022: 4PM EST. || On Friday, August 5, 2022, Hearts with Hands sent a third shipment of supplies to Eastern Kentucky. Local business owner, A.J, transported 12 pallets containing Box of Hope food boxes, hygiene kits, cleaning supplies, gallon water, bottled water, paper products, assorted stuffed toys. These items were received by First Church of God, Pastor Bobby Hollon, Jackson, Kentucky.

Hearts with Hands would like to thank Ingles for donating 12 pallets of water and 6 pallets of bleach to aid with disaster relief in Kentucky.

On Wednesday, August 10, Hearts with Hands sent a fourth shipment of supplies to Kentucky, A.J James of Emission Air transported 6,751 lbs of items to include miscellaneous medical supplies, gallons of water, wipes, disinfectants, food boxes and paper products. These items were received by Rock Bottom Baptist Church, Pastor Bowling, in Buckhorn, Kentucky.

Swannanoa, NC, July 31, 2022: 7AM EST. || Hearts with Hands continues relief efforts for victims of the devastating floods in Eastern Kentucky. A second shipment of supplies left our warehouse this morning, to arrive at East Perry Elementary School, Hazard, Kentucky. The truck contains 24 pallets, 17,510 lbs of water, Box of Hope non-perishable food boxes, hygiene kits, cleaning supplies, paper products and assorted clothing. Swannanoa, NC, July 29, 2022: 10:00 AM EST. || The first shipment of immediate relief supplies left our warehouse this morning, en route to Eastern Kentucky. Two of our volunteers will travel to Eastern Kentucky to serve victims of the devastating floods. Shipment is 9,010 pounds of water, Box of Hope non-perishable food boxes, hygiene kits, cleaning supplies, and paper products.
